

MORGAN'S PAW WARMERS

A knitting pattern

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This is a quick knit, super easy beginner's project, worked up quickly in superbulky yarn. The original set above was both designed and knit by Smaller Daughter, then age 6 – her very first solo project.

Skills required- cast on, cast off, garter stitch, half hitch cast on at end of row, K2tog. Sewing up.

Materials

- Small quantity of superbulky yarn. The one we used was 100% acrylic, left over airy bulky from a roll originally bought as holiday present ties.
- US #10.5 straight single-pointed needles.
- Tapestry needle for weaving in the ends

Gauge

Approximately 2 stitches = 1 inch in garter stitch.

Instructions

Cast on 16 stitches. Knit in garter stitch until piece measures about 6 inches long.

Bind off four stitches, and knit across remainder of row. Knit next row, casting on four stitches at the end.

On the next row, (K3, K2tog), repeat across the row, ending K1. Knit three more rows on the remaining 13 stitches. Bind off.

Sew side seam, taking care to leave the thumb slit open..
